## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

### AN ACT

Relative to Imperfect Weaving in Factories.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The system used by manufacturers of  
2 grading the work of a weaver shall not affect or lessen  
3 the wages of the weaver, and in no case shall deductions  
4 be made from the weaver's wages because of imperfect  
5 weaving, but nothing in this act shall take away the right  
6 of the manufacturer to recover back in an action at law  
7 from the weaver any sum paid to the weaver which is  
8 fairly due because of imperfect weaving caused by im-  
9 perfections in the weaver's own work.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
