Bill accompanying the petition of Michael H. Cotter for legislation to permit ball playing on the Lord's day. Legal Affairs. January 19.

AN ACT

Making it Legal to play Ball on the Lord's Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be lawful to play ball on the
2 Lord's day after one o'clock in the afternoon: *provided*,
3 that this act shall not apply to games of ball at which an
4 admission fee is charged, or to games played by other than
5 amateur players.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect in any city or
2 town upon its acceptance by the voters thereof voting
3 thereon at any state or municipal election.
