

HOUSE No. 1330

Bill accompanying the petition of Charles H. Morrill and others for legislation relative to the cutting of ice on certain ponds. Public Health. January 19.

AN ACT

Relative to cutting Ice on Certain Ponds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for the city councils of
2 cities and selectmen of towns bordering upon ponds or
3 other waters used for supplying water or ice for domestic
4 or like purposes to grant the right to cut ice from such
5 waters upon such terms as they may prescribe, and only
6 persons so authorized shall be permitted to cut ice as
7 aforesaid.

1 SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent here-
2 with are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
