

HOUSE No. 1370

Bill accompanying the petition of Theodore L. Sorenson for legislation relative to the fares of street and elevated railway companies during certain hours. Street Railways. January 19.

AN ACT

Relative to Fares charged during Certain Hours by Street and Elevated Railway Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. On all street and elevated railways in this
2 commonwealth the fares which are now five cents shall be
3 reduced to three cents between the hours of six and eight
4 in the morning and five and seven in the evening.

1 SECTION 2. Violation of this act shall be punished by
2 fine or imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
