## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Office of the Controller of County Accounts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the  
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the  
4 controller of county accounts, for the fiscal year  
5 ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen  
6 hundred and eleven, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the controller, twenty-five hun-  
8 dred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 21.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$2,500.)

9 For the salary of the first deputy, eighteen hun-  
10 dred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 21.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$1,800.)

11 For the salary of the second deputy, fifteen hun-  
12 dred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 21.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$1,500.)

13 For the salary of the third deputy, twelve hun-  
14 dred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 21.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$1,200.)

15 For traveling and office expenses of the control-  
16 ler and of his deputies, including printing and  
17 binding the annual report, a sum not exceeding  
18 eighteen hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 21;  
19 Acts 1902, ch. 438.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$1,800.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
