

*Chap.660* AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF THE TAX ON THE TELEVISIONING OR BROADCASTING OF BOXING OR SPARRING MATCHES.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

G. L. (Ter. Ed.), 147, § 40, etc., amended.

Payment to commonwealth by certain licensees, regulated.

Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 40, as amended by chapter 203 of the acts of 1952, and inserting in place thereof the following section: — *Section 40.* Every licensee holding or conducting any such boxing or sparring match or exhibition shall, within seventy-two hours after its conclusion, pay to the state treasurer a sum equal to five per cent of the total gross receipts from the sale of tickets or from admission fees, and such licensee shall at least twenty-four hours before such exhibition pay to the state treasurer a sum equal to five per cent of the total amount paid or to be paid for television or broadcasting rights, such sum to be paid by the said licensee irrespective of whether he himself ever receives such amount or any portion thereof; provided, that if such match or exhibition is conducted as an incidental feature in an event or entertainment of a different character, such portion of the said total receipts and the said total amount shall be paid to the commonwealth as the commission may determine or as may be fixed by rule adopted under section forty-six. Within seventy-two hours after its conclusion the licensee shall furnish to the commission a report, duly verified by the treasurer and secretary, showing the exact number of tickets sold and admission fees collected for the contest, and the gross receipts thereof, and such other data as the commission may require.

*Chap.661* AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS AND ASSISTANT REGISTERS OF DEEDS FOR THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

G. L. (Ter. Ed.), 36, § 33, etc., amended.

Salaries.

Section 33 of chapter 36 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph, as amended by chapter 543 of the acts of 1952, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

The salary of the register of deeds for the county of Suffolk shall be thirteen thousand dollars, the salary of the first assistant register of deeds for said county shall be eighty-eight hundred dollars, and the salaries of all other assistant registers of deeds for said county shall be eighty-two hundred dollars.
