AN ACT

To authorize Instruction in the Public Schools in the Application of Surgical Remedies and First Aid for the Injured.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Instruction may be given in the public schools in the
- 2 application of surgical remedies in cases of emergency and
- 3 the principles of first aid for the injured. School com-
- 4 mittees may expend for this purpose such sums from the
- 5 appropriation for salaries of teachers as they may deem
- 6 necessary.
