### AN ACT

To authorize Cities and Towns to provide Meals for School Children.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. School committees in cities and towns may  
2 provide meals free, or at such price not exceeding the cost  
3 as they may fix, for children attending the public schools  
4 therein, and cities and towns may appropriate money for  
5 this purpose.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
