AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in the Department of the Insurance Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are ap-
2 propriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the com-
3 monwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the insurance
4 department, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day
5 of November, nineteen hundred and eleven, to wit: —

6 For the salary of the commissioner, five thousand dol-
7 lars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$5,000.)

8 For the salary of the deputy commissioner, thirty-five
9 hundred dollars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$3,500.)

10 For the salary of the examiner, three thousand dollars.
11 (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$3,000.)

12 For the salary of the actuary, two thousand dollars.
13 (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$2,000.)

14 For the salary of the chief clerk, two thousand dollars.

15 (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$2,000.)

16 For the salary of the second clerk, fifteen hundred dol-

17 lars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$1,500.)

18 For the salary of the third clerk, twelve hundred dol-

19 lars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$1,200.)

20 For additional clerks and assistants, a sum not exceed-

21 ing thirty-eight thousand dollars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$37,500.)

22 For incidental and contingent expenses, a sum not ex-

23 ceeding eleven thousand dollars. (Acts 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$11,000.)

24 For printing and binding the annual report, a sum not

25 exceeding sixty-three hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 9,

26 sect. 7; Acts 1902, ch. 438; 1907, ch. 576.)

(Appropriation 1910, \$5,800.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
