

HOUSE No. 1829

Bill accompanying the petition of Benjamin D. Gifford and others for legislation to authorize the construction of two bridges over Herring river in the town of Harwich. Roads and Bridges. April 24.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

To authorize the Construction and Maintenance of two Bridges across Herring River in the Town of Harwich.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Barnstable
2 county, or the town of Harwich, may build and maintain
3 a bridge, without a draw, across Herring river in the
4 town of Harwich, in the same location now occupied by
5 Herring River Lower bridge, so called, near the residence
6 of Thomas L. Snow.

1 SECTION 2. The said county commissioners, or the
2 town of Harwich, may also build and maintain a bridge,
3 without a draw, across Herring river in the town of

4 Harwich, on the upper county road, in the location known
5 as the Job Chase bridge, near the residence formerly of
6 Caleb Chase.

1 SECTION 3. All acts of the town of Harwich heretofore
2 done in the building and maintaining of a bridge with-
3 out a draw at the said Job Chase bridge location are
4 hereby ratified and confirmed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall be subject to the provisions
2 of chapter ninety-six of the Revised Laws of the Common-
3 wealth.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
