## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

### AN ACT

To provide for repaying to the Town of Amesbury the Sum paid by it toward the Rebuilding of the Fender Pier of the Essex Merrimac Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county of Essex is hereby authorized  
2 to pay to the town of Amesbury the sum of six thousand  
3 fifty-two dollars and twenty-two cents, being the amount  
4 paid by the said town into the treasury of the county of  
5 Essex as its share of the cost of rebuilding the fender pier  
6 of the Essex Merrimac bridge, under the provisions of  
7 chapter four hundred and thirty-seven of the acts of the  
8 year nineteen hundred and seven.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of paying the aforesaid  
2 amount the county of Essex is hereby authorized to issue  
3 notes or bonds to the said amount payable within twelve  
4 months from the date thereof.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
