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### RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the State Infirmary.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid from the  
2 treasury of the commonwealth for improvements at the  
3 state infirmary, the following sums to expended under  
4 the direction of the trustees of the infirmary:— For  
5 additions to and alterations in the chapel, a sum not ex-  
6 ceeding eleven thousand five hundred dollars; for con-  
7 struction of a women's special ward, a sum not exceeding  
8 twenty-two thousand dollars; and for the purchase of real  
9 estate, a sum not exceeding one thousand two hundred  
10 dollars.
