AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of the New
Hospital for Dipsomaniacs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of ten thousand dollars is hereby
2 appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of the com-
3 monwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the care and
4 maintenance of the new hospital for dipsomaniacs in the
5 towns of Norfolk and Walpole during the present year.
6 (Acts 1910, ch. 635.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
