### RESOLVE

To provide for the Construction of a Bridge and Approaches Thereto to carry the Driveway of the Quincy Shore Reservation over the Tracks of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Company in the City of Quincy.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 Metropolitan Parks Maintenance Fund a sum not exceed-  
3 ing twenty thousand dollars, to be expended under the  
4 direction of the metropolitan park commission for the  
5 purpose of constructing, or of contributing toward the  
6 expense of constructing, a bridge and approaches thereto  
7 to carry the driveway of Quincy shore reservation over the  
8 tracks of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Rail-  
9 road Company in the city of Quincy.
