RESOLVE

In Favor of Alfred E. Kenrick and M. Frank Kenrick and the Estate of James M. Seamans.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 Abolition of Grade Crossings Loan Fund to Alfred E.
3 Kenrick and M. Frank Kenrick the sum of two hundred
4 and twenty dollars and seventy-two cents, and to the exec-
5 utors of the will of James M. Seamans, late of Brookline,
6 deceased, which will has been duly proved and allowed in
7 the probate court for the county of Norfolk, the sum of
8 eighty-five dollars and forty-seven cents, said payments
9 to be made in full compensation for damages to said real
10 estate so far as the commonwealth is concerned, which
11 damages were occasioned by reason of the abolition of the
12 grade crossing at Kerrigan place in said town of Brook-
13 line.
