

SENATE No. 88

To accompany the petition of John F. Malley that provision be made for an investigation of the present conditions of sewerage along the Connecticut River Valley. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation of the Present Conditions of Sewerage along the Connecticut River Valley.

- 1 *Resolved*, 1. That the governor, by and with the advice
2 and consent of the council, is hereby authorized and di-
3 rected to appoint a board of three experts resident in
4 cities and towns of the Connecticut river and tributaries
5 in Massachusetts.
- 6 2. That said board is to serve for one year and is to
7 investigate and report to the general court of nineteen
8 hundred and twelve as to the present conditions of sewer-
9 age along the Connecticut river and tributaries in Massa-
10 chusetts, together with any recommendations as to the
11 establishment of a Connecticut river sewer district upon
12 the general lines of the metropolitan sewer district of
13 Boston, and also any recommendations or specifications
14 as to most approved method of sewage disposal with a
15 view of purifying the said river and tributaries.

16 3. That to meet the expenses incurred under this act,
17 an appropriation of not over shall
18 be made, to be paid out of the treasury of the common-
19 wealth of Massachusetts.

20 4. That the said board shall be authorized to employ
21 any requisite assistants, to establish offices and to incur
22 any legitimate expense incidental to their work.

23 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
