To accompany the petition of the Boston Association for the Relief and Control of Tuberculosis by Robert Treat Paine, president, that the work of the State inspectors of health relative to tuberculosis and other diseases be extended. Public Health.

AN ACT

Relative to the Health Districts and to the Inspectors of Health of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state board of health for the purpose of
2 carrying out the provisions of chapter five hundred
3 and thirty-seven of the acts of the year nineteen
4 hundred and seven and of acts in amendment
5 thereof is hereby authorized to furnish the state
6 inspectors of health with such assistance for the
7 employment of persons or otherwise as said board
8 may from time to time consider necessary to carry
9 out the provisions of said act or its amendments,
10 at an expense not to exceed six thousand dollars in
11 addition to the sum now authorized.
