## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

Relative to Tuition Fees in Textile Schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 No charge shall be made for the tuition in any  
2 textile school of the commonwealth of any student  
3 who is a resident of the commonwealth and of the  
4 city in which such school is located. The charge for  
5 tuition of students who are residents of any other  
6 of the United States shall be two hundred dollars  
7 per annum, and the charge for tuition in such school  
8 for residents of foreign countries shall be five hun-  
9 dred dollars per annum.
