

SENATE No. 137

To accompany the petition of G. Frederick Robinson that a part of the Charles River in the town of Watertown be dredged and that an anchorage basin be established therein. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

RESOLVE

To provide for the Dredging of a Part of the Charles River above the Galen Street Bridge in the Town of Watertown and for an Anchorage or Mooring Basin in the Vicinity of that Bridge.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 Metropolitan Parks Maintenance Fund a sum not ex-
3 ceeding ten thousand dollars, to be expended under the
4 direction of the metropolitan park commission for the
5 purpose of dredging Charles river above the Galen street
6 bridge, so called, in the town of Watertown and for pro-
7 viding an anchorage or mooring basin in the vicinity of
8 said bridge.
