To accompany the petition of John H. Burdakin that the compensation of registers of deeds be increased to an amount equal to the fees heretofore received by them. Public Service.

AN ACT

Relative to the Compensation of Registers of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In determining the compensation of
2 registers of deeds in accordance with the provisions
3 of chapter four hundred and fifty-two of the acts
4 of nineteen hundred and four there shall be added
5 to the actual receipts an amount equal to the regular
6 fees theretofore charged for recording any instru-
7 ments which according to the provisions of laws
8 passed subsequent to nineteen hundred and four are
9 to be recorded without fees.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
