## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Intoxicating Lipuors by Innholders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second clause of section seven-  
2 teen of chapter one hundred of the Revised Laws  
3 is hereby amended by striking out the word " six ",  
4 in the seventh line of said section, and inserting in  
5 place thereof the word:— eight,— and by strik-  
6 ing out the word " six ", in the ninth line of said  
7 section, and inserting in place thereof the word:  
8 — eight,— so that the said clause shall read:—  
9 Second, That spirituous or intoxicating liquor  
10 shall not be sold between the hours of eleven at

11 night and eight in the morning or on the Lord's  
12 day; but if the licensee is also licensed as an inn-  
13 holder he may, between the hours of eight in the  
14 morning and eleven at night on the Lord's day,  
15 supply such liquor to guests who have resorted to  
16 his inn for food or lodging.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
