To accompany the petition of Joseph H. Hibbard that the municipal authorities of the city of Lowell and the town of Tyngsborough be authorized to permit speed tests or contests on certain highways during the present year. Roads and Bridges.

AN ACT

To authorize the Municipal Authorities of the City of Lowell and of the Town of Tyngsborough to permit Speed Tests or Contests upon Certain Highways during Certain Days in the Current Year.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor and board of aldermen
2 of the city of Lowell and the selectmen of the town
3 of Tyngsborough may, after a public hearing, and
4 subject to such regulations concerning the closing,
5 use and control of the highways as they deem neces-
6 sary for public convenience and safety, grant per-
7 mits to persons to drive motor cycles and auto-
8 mobiles in speed tests or contests during specified
9 times and upon specified parts of any public way

10 or ways, in their city or town, respectively, during
11 any three days between the first day of September
12 and the first day of October of the current year,
13 both inclusive: *provided*, that no highway shall be
14 closed on the Lord's day nor shall any practice,
15 exhibition or speed tests or contests be permitted
16 on that day.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
