

SENATE No. 277

To accompany the petition of S. W. McCaslin and others for legislation relative to the taking of quahaugs in the waters of Eastham, Orleans and Wellfleet. Fisheries and Game.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

Relative to taking Quahaugs in the Waters of Eastham, Orleans and Wellfleet.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of the acts of nineteen
2 hundred and four, chapter two hundred and sixty-
3 nine, is hereby amended by striking out the word
4 " may ", in the second line thereof, and inserting
5 in its place the word:— shall,— so that said sec-
6 tion as amended will read as follows:— *Section*
7 3. The selectmen of any one of said towns shall
8 give to any inhabitants of any of said towns per-
9 mits in writing to take quahaugs from their beds
10 in the town which the selectmen represent at such
11 times, in such quantities and for such uses as they

12 shall deem expedient. Such permits shall be good
 13 for such time as the selectmen may determine, not
 14 exceeding one year. Any inhabitant of the com-
 15 monwealth may without such permit take from the
 16 natural beds in said towns quahaugs for the use
 17 of his family, not exceeding in quantity one bushel,
 18 including shells, in any one day and any fisherman
 19 may without such permit take quahaugs from the
 20 natural beds in his own town for bait for his own
 21 use, not exceeding in quantity one bushel, includ-
 22 ing shells, in any one day.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
 2 passage.
