

SENATE No. 300

To accompany the petition of John W. Converse and another that the Great Council of Massachusetts of the Improved Order of Red Men be authorized to pay death or funeral or disability benefits to its members. Insurance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

To authorize the Great Council of Massachusetts of the Improved Order of Red Men to pay Death or Funeral and Disability Benefits to its Members.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Great Council of Massachusetts
2 of the Improved Order of Red Men, a corporation
3 incorporated under the laws of the commonwealth,
4 may pay death or funeral benefits not exceeding in
5 any one case two hundred dollars in amount, and
6 disability benefits not exceeding in any one case
7 ten dollars a week to its members.

1 SECTION 2. The said corporation shall, except as
2 herein otherwise provided, be subject to the provi-

3 sions of the fraternal beneficiary law applicable
4 to fraternal organizations designated in section
5 twelve of chapter one hundred and nineteen of the
6 Revised Laws and amendments thereof.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
