AN ACT

To provide for establishing a Station for the Propagation of
Game Birds and Animals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The commissioners on fisheries and game
2 are hereby authorized to acquire land and buildings by
3 gift, lease, purchase, or devise, for one or more stations
4 for the propagation of game birds and animals, to erect
5 necessary buildings, to purchase stock for breeding, and
6 to take such other steps as they may deem expedient for
7 the protection, propagation and distribution of the birds
8 and animals reared at the said station. For this purpose
9 they may expend a sum not exceeding ten thousand dol-
10 lars, subject to the approval of the governor and council.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
