RESOLVE

In Favor of Ella Raymond.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth an annuity of three hun-
3 dred dollars to Ella Raymond of Malden, formerly of
4 Lowell, whose husband was rendered unable to labor by
5 injuries received in the discharge of militia duty at
6 Framingham. Said annuity shall begin on the first day
7 of January in the year nineteen hundred and twelve,
8 shall be paid quarterly, and shall continue for the term
9 of five years should said Ella Raymond so long survive.
