## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Removal of Officers in Attendance upon the Supreme Judicial Court and the Superior Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Officers appointed as court officers to be  
2 in attendance upon the sessions of the superior court  
3 and supreme judicial court in any county shall hold  
4 office during good behavior and until they are removed  
5 by the sheriff of the county for which they were ap-  
6 pointed, for cause approved by the justices of the supe-  
7 rior court, or supreme judicial court, or a majority of  
8 them.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
