

HOUSE No. 634

Bill accompanying the petition of Harry B. Putnam for legislation to establish the salaries of the judges of certain district courts. Public Service. January 12.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

AN ACT

To establish the Salaries of the Judges of Certain District Courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The paragraph headed Class G of section
2 one of chapter four hundred and fifty-three of the acts
3 of the year nineteen hundred and four is hereby amended
4 by striking out in the tenth line of said paragraph, the
5 word "fifteen hundred dollars", and inserting in place
6 thereof the words:—eighteen hundred dollars,— so as
7 to read as follows:—*Class G.* Courts whose judicial
8 districts have a population of from twenty thousand to
9 thirty thousand, to wit, the first district court of southern
10 Worcester, the district court of central Berkshire, the dis-
11 trict court of northern Berkshire, the first district court
12 of northern Worcester, the fourth district court of Bristol,
13 the second district court of eastern Worcester, the district

14 court of western Worcester, the district court of western
15 Norfolk and the first district court of southern Middlesex;
16 salaries: justice, eighteen hundred dollars; clerk, nine
17 hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The paragraph headed Class H of section
2 one of chapter four hundred and fifty-three of the acts
3 of the year nineteen hundred and four, as amended by
4 chapter four hundred and forty-three, of the acts of the
5 year nineteen hundred and five, is hereby amended by
6 striking out, in the seventeenth line of said paragraph,
7 the words "twelve hundred dollars", and inserting in
8 place thereof the words:— fifteen hundred dollars,— so
9 as to read as follows:— *Class H.* Courts whose judicial
10 districts have a population of from ten thousand to twenty
11 thousand, to wit, the municipal court of Brookline, the
12 municipal court of the Brighton district, the police court
13 of Chicopee, the district court of central Middlesex, the
14 second district court of southern Worcester, the district
15 court of western Hampden, the police court of Newbury-
16 port, the third district court of Plymouth, the first district
17 court of northern Middlesex, the third district court of
18 southern Worcester, the second district court of Barn-
19 stable, the first district court of eastern Worcester, the
20 fourth district court of Plymouth, the district court of
21 southern Norfolk, the police court of Marlborough, the
22 fourth district court of Berkshire, the district court of
23 eastern Hampden, the first district court of Barnstable,
24 the second district court of Essex, the district court of
25 southern Berkshire and the police court of Lee; salaries:
26 justice, fifteen hundred dollars; clerk, seven hundred and
27 twenty dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
