Bill accompanying the petition of James W. Bean for legislation to increase the compensation of the porters at the State House. Public Service. January 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

AN ACT

To increase the Compensation of the Porters at the State House.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Each of the porters at the state house
2 shall be paid an annual salary of nine hundred dollars,
3 to be so allowed and paid from the first day of January
4 in the year nineteen hundred and twelve.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
