Bill accompanying the petition of John T. Shea for legislation to authorize the Metropolitan Park Commission to construct a boulevard or parkway in the vicinity of Fresh pond in the city of Cambridge. Metropolitan Affairs. January 17.

AN ACT

To Increase the Amount of Money to be placed at the Disposal of the Metropolitan Park Commission for Boulevard Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission, cre-
2 ated by chapter four hundred and seven of the acts of
3 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, for the pur-
4 pose of carrying out the provisions of that act and of
5 chapter two hundred and eighty-eight of the acts of the
6 year eighteen hundred and ninety-four and all acts in
7 amendment thereof or in addition thereto, and for com-
8 pleting the boulevard or parkway from a point at the
9 junction of Fresh Pond parkway and Huron avenue in
10 Cambridge, over land of the city of Cambridge under

11 the control of the water board of said city and the
12 Fitchburg division of the Boston & Maine Railroad, to
13 a point in the existing road around the southerly side of
14 Fresh Pond, and to expend a sufficient amount of money
15 therefor.

1 SECTION 2. To meet the expenditures made under
2 authority of this act the treasurer and receiver general,
3 with the approval of the governor and council, shall
4 issue scrip or certificates of indebtedness, bearing in-
5 terest at the rate not exceeding four per cent per an-
6 num, to the said amount of _____ dollars,
7 as an addition to the Metropolitan Parks Loan, series
8 two, at such times and in such sums as the said com-
9 mission shall certify to him to be necessary to meet the
10 liabilities incurred by said commission under acts afore-
11 said, and shall add to the existing sinking fund to
12 provide for the payment of the same. Such scrip or
13 certificates of indebtedness shall be issued, and additions
14 to said sinking fund shall be assessed and collected,
15 in accordance with the provisions of sections eight, ten
16 and eleven of said chapter two hundred and eighty-eight,
17 and in accordance with the provisions of chapter two
18 hundred and eighty-three of the acts of the year eighteen
19 hundred and ninety-five, and of chapter four hundred
20 and nineteen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
21 and ninety-nine.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
