

HOUSE No. 1296

Bill accompanying the petition of George C. Hett and others for legislation to provide for compensating the town of Belmont for loss of taxes on property of the McLean Hospital and Convalescent Home. Taxation. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Belmont to tax Certain Hospital Property in the Said Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The real estate in the town of Belmont
2 of the McLean hospital for the insane and the convales-
3 cent home, both being departments of the trustees of the
4 Massachusetts general hospital, shall be liable for taxa-
5 tion by the said town in the same manner and to the same
6 extent as other real estate in the said town.

1 SECTION 2. So much of any act as is inconsistent here-
2 with is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
