

HOUSE No. 1469

Bill accompanying the petition of John F. Fitzgerald, mayor, for legislation to authorize the city of Boston to manufacture and distribute gas and electricity. Public Lighting. January 18.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

AN ACT

Authorizing the City of Boston to manufacture and distribute Gas or Electricity for Furnishing Light, Heat or Power for Municipal or County Use, and for the Use of its Inhabitants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may, in accord-
2 ance with this act, construct and maintain within
3 its limits one or more plants for the manufacture
4 or distribution of gas or electricity for furnishing
5 light, heat or power for its municipal and county
6 buildings, and for the use of its inhabitants; such
7 plants may include suitable land, structures and
8 machinery and other apparatus and appliances for
9 manufacturing and distributing gas and electricity

10 for said purposes, and may for said purpose place
11 and maintain in the streets of said city conduits,
12 pipes and wires.

1 SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsis-
2 ent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
