## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

For the Retirement of Clerks of the Supreme Judicial Court  
and of the Superior Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 Any clerk of the supreme court and of the superior  
2 court, for civil or criminal business, who has attained the  
3 age of sixty-five years and has served continuously for  
4 thirty years, may retire from active service and shall  
5 receive, during the remainder of his life, an amount equal  
6 to three-fourths of the salary which was by law payable  
7 to him at the time of his retirement.
