AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses of the Massachusetts Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 salaries and expenses of the Massachusetts high-
5 way commission, for the fiscal year ending on the
6 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
7 twelve, to wit:—

8 For the salaries of the commissioners, the sum
9 of seventy-seven hundred and fifty dollars. (Rev.
10 Laws, ch. 47, sect. 1.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$8,500.)

11 For the salaries of the engineers, clerks and as-
12 sistants, a sum not exceeding twenty-one thousand
13 five hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 47.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$21,500.)

14 For traveling and other expenses of the commis-
15 sion, a sum not exceeding thirty-five hundred dol-
16 lars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 47.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$3,500.)

17 For postage, printing and other necessary office
18 expenses, including printing and binding the an-
19 nual report, a sum not exceeding sixty-five hundred
20 dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 47.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$6,500.)

21 For rent of offices, a sum not exceeding forty-
22 seven hundred and fifty dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch.
23 47.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$4,750.)

24 For care and repair of road-building machinery,
25 a sum not exceeding seventy-five hundred dollars.
26 (Rev. Laws, ch. 47, sect. 19.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$6,500.)

27 For the maintenance of state highways, for the
28 present and previous years, a sum not exceeding
29 two hundred thousand dollars. (Acts 1904, ch. 244;
30 1908, ch. 642.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$200,000.)

31 For the suppression of the gypsy and brown-tail
32 moths and other insect pests which threaten the
33 trees on state highways, a sum not exceeding ten
34 thousand dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 642.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$10,000.)

35 For the repair of a certain highway in the town
36 of Truro, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars.
37 (Acts 1911, ch. 416.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
