## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the Gardner State Colony.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated for the maintenance of the Gardner  
3 state colony for the fiscal year ending on the thir-  
4 tieth day of November, nineteen hundred and  
5 twelve, to wit:—

6 From the receipts of said colony now in the  
7 treasury of the commonwealth, the sum of twenty-  
8 six hundred eighty-one dollars and forty-six cents;  
9 and from the treasury of the commonwealth, from  
10 the ordinary revenue, a sum not exceeding one  
11 hundred thirty thousand eight hundred eighteen  
12 dollars and fifty-four cents. (Acts 1905, ch. 175;  
13 1909, ch. 504.)

(Appropriation 1911, \$114,414.11.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
