AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the
Boston State Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated for the maintenance of the Boston
3 state hospital for the fiscal year ending on the thir-
4 tieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
5 twelve, to wit:—

6 From the receipts of said hospital now in the
7 treasury of the commonwealth, the sum of twenty-
8 eight thousand six hundred forty-one dollars and
9 twenty cents; and from the treasury of the com-
10 monwealth, from the ordinary revenue, a sum not
11 exceeding two hundred seventy-seven thousand
12 three hundred fifty-eight dollars and eighty cents.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
