RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Massachusetts
Agricultural College.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the treas-
2 ury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding one hundred
3 and twenty-five thousand dollars, to be expended at the
4 Massachusetts agricultural college, under the direction of
5 the trustees thereof, for the following purposes, to wit:—
6 For erecting a students' dormitory, a sum not exceeding
7 twenty-five thousand dollars; for erecting an addition to
8 Draper hall, a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand dol-
9 lars; for a system of sewerage for the college, a sum not
10 exceeding ten thousand dollars; for new equipment for the
11 farm, dairy building, dining hall and for miscellaneous
12 teaching equipment for various departments, a sum not
13 exceeding twenty thousand dollars; for repairs and minor
14 improvements, a sum not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars;
15 for general improvements, including an addition to the
16 poultry plant, an addition to the young stock barn, the
17 piggery, development of the campus and miscellaneous
18 improvements, a sum not exceeding thirty thousand dollars.
