AN ACT

Making an Additional Appropriation for Military Expenses in preserving Order during the Strike of Mill Operatives in the City of Lawrence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding thirty thou-
2 sand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid
3 out of the treasury of the commonwealth from
4 the ordinary revenue, to meet the military ex-
5 penses incurred in preserving order in the city
6 of Lawrence during the period of the strike in
7 certain mills, the same to be in addition to any
8 amount heretofore authorized for this purpose.
9 Bills therefor shall be approved by the adjutant
10 general and shall be filed with the auditor of the
11 commonwealth for payment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
