RESOLVE

To provide for dredging an Anchorage Basin in Lynn Harbor

- 1 *Resolved*, That the board of harbor and land commis-
- 2 sioners is hereby authorized, in its discretion, to continue
- 3 the dredging of an anchorage basin in Lynn harbor east of
- 4 the main channel to a depth of not less than six feet at mean
- 5 low water, and outside of the proposed situation for the
- 6 Market street extension boulevard, and may expend for
- 7 this purpose a sum not exceeding twenty thousand dollars
- 8 in addition to the ten thousand dollars authorized for this
- 9 purpose by chapter one hundred and ten of the resolves of
- 10 the year nineteen hundred and eight.
