**RESOLVE**

Authorizing the Directors of the Port of Boston to Improve a  
Channel in Quincy Bay.

1 *Resolved*, That the directors of the port of Boston shall  
2 improve the channel in Quincy bay, formerly dredged by  
3 the commonwealth, extending to the club houses of the  
4 Wollaston Yacht Club and the Squantum Yacht Club, by  
5 widening and deepening the same so that it shall be seventy  
6 feet in width on the bottom and three feet deep at mean low  
7 water, and also by extending the present channel, with a  
8 width of seventy feet and a depth of three feet at mean low  
9 water, until it reaches a point in the bay where the water is  
10 three feet deep at mean low water. For the above purpose  
11 the directors may expend a sum not exceeding six thousand  
12 dollars, to be paid out of the Commonwealth Flats Improve-  
13 ment Fund.
