Bill accompanying the petition of George T. Daly for legislation relative to the care of private ways in the city of Boston. Cities. January 1.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to Private Ways in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Whoever throws, drops or places and suf-
2 fers to remain in any private way in the city of Boston
3 which is open to travel, any snow or ice, or any refuse
4 or rubbish, or obstruction of any kind, shall be punished
5 by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each offence.

1 SECTION 2. The city of Boston may remove from
2 private ways all noxious and refuse substances, but shall
3 not be liable for entering upon, or for any defect or
4 want of repair in private ways.
