Resolve accompanying the petition of the mayor of the city of Boston for an investigation of the practical workings of the single tax system. Taxation. January 1.

RESOLVE

Providing for an Investigation of the Practical Workings of the Single Tax System.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor, with the advice and con-
2 sent of the council, shall, within thirty days after the
3 passage of this resolve, appoint a commission of three
4 persons, citizens of this commonwealth, of whom one
5 shall be a representative of labor, to study and investi-
6 gate the single tax system and its practical workings and
7 to report upon the advisability and practicability of its
8 adoption by this commonwealth. The said commission
9 may employ experts and all necessary clerical and other
10 assistance and may incur such reasonable expenses as
11 may be authorized by the governor and council. Before
12 incurring any expenses the commission shall, from time
13 to time, estimate its probable amount, and submit the
14 estimate to the governor and council for their approval,
15 and no expense shall be incurred by the commission
