Bill accompanying the petition of Edgar M. Hixson and others for legislation to authorize towns to discontinue the appointment of town accountants. Towns. January 1.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Tenure of Office of Town Accountants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any town which has authorized its select-
2 men to appoint a town accountant in accordance with the
3 provisions of chapter six hundred and twenty-four of the
4 acts of the year nineteen hundred and ten, may at any
5 subsequent town meeting, or at any meeting duly called
6 for the purpose, revoke such authority; but if a town
7 accountant is in office at the time of such revocation he
8 or she shall continue to hold his office and perform its
9 duties during the year for which he or she was appointed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
