

HOUSE No. 144

Bill accompanying the petition of Fred W. Grant and others for legislation to set off certain territory from the town of Foxborough and annex the same to the town of Walpole. Towns. January 2.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To change and establish the Boundary Line between the
Towns of Foxborough and Walpole.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby set off from the town of
2 Foxborough and annexed to and made a part of the town
3 of Walpole a certain tract of land with its inhabitants and
4 all estates therein bounded and described, to wit: all
5 that part of the town of Foxborough lying northerly of a
6 straight line running approximately south seventy-three
7 degrees west from the intersection of the present bound-
8 ary between the town of Foxborough and Walpole with
9 the street known as Water street in Walpole and North
10 street in Foxborough (being the street from South Wal-
11 pole to Foxborough) till it intersects said boundary line

12 again at a point southwest of the property of one Mor-
13 rissey.

1 SECTION 2. The inhabitants and the estates within the
2 territory hereby annexed to the town of Walpole and the
3 owners of said estates shall pay to the town of Foxbor-
4 ough all arrearages of taxes which have been and shall
5 be legally assessed upon them before this act takes effect,
6 and shall pay also until the next state valuation such
7 proportion of the state and county taxes as it may be
8 legally incumbent upon them to pay, and said taxes may
9 be collected in the same manner as if the territory hereby
10 annexed to said town still remained a part of the town of
11 Foxborough.

1 SECTION 3. The town of Walpole shall be liable for
2 the support of all persons who now stand or hereafter
3 shall stand in need of relief as paupers whose settlement
4 has been gained whether by original acquisition or deri-
5 vation or in any other manner within the territory hereby
6 annexed to the town of Walpole.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
