The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of Vocational
Agricultural Departments in Certain High Schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are ap-
2 propriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the com-
3 monwealth from the ordinary revenue, for meeting the
4 commonwealth's proportion of the cost of maintaining
5 vocational agricultural departments in the high schools
6 of certain towns for the period prior to December first,
7 nineteen hundred and twelve, under the authority of
8 sections eight, nine and ten of chapter four hundred and
9 seventy-one of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
10 and eleven, to wit:—

11 To the town of Petersham, the sum of eight hundred
12 seven dollars and fifty cents;

13 To the town of Hadley, the sum of six hundred forty-
14 six dollars and sixty-seven cents ;

15 To the town of Northborough, the sum of seven hun-
16 dred seventy-five dollars ;

17 To the town of Harwich, the sum of five hundred
18 thirty-three dollars and thirty cents ;

19 To the town of Easton the sum of four hundred
20 dollars.

21 For one half the tuition of pupils attending the voca-
22 tional agricultural department at Petersham prior to
23 December first, nineteen hundred and twelve, due the
24 following towns, to wit :—

25 To the town of Dana, the sum of one hundred dollars ;

26 To the town of New Salem, the sum of ten dollars ;

27 To the town of Phillipston, the sum of twenty-two
28 dollars and fifty cents ;

29 To the city of Springfield, the sum of twenty dollars.

30 For one half the tuition of pupils attending the voca-
31 tional agricultural department at Hadley, prior to De-
32 cember first, nineteen hundred and twelve, due the
33 following town, to wit :—

34 To the town of Amherst, the sum of twenty dollars.

35 For one half the tuition of pupils attending the voca-
36 tional agricultural department at Northborough, prior to
37 December first, nineteen hundred and twelve, due the
38 following towns, to wit :—

39 To the town of Southborough, the sum of fifteen dol-
40 lars ;

41 To the town of Westborough, the sum of one hundred
42 dollars ;

43 To the town of Berlin, the sum of fifty dollars ;

44 To the town of Shrewsbury, the sum of fifty dollars.

45 For one half the tuition of the pupils attending the
46 vocational agricultural department at Harwich, prior to

47 December first, nineteen hundred and twelve, due the
48 following towns, to wit:—

49 To the town of Brewster, the sum of twenty-seven
50 dollars and seventy-eight cents;

51 To the town of Chatham, the sum of fifty dollars;

52 To the town of Truro, the sum of eleven dollars and
53 eleven cents.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
