

Bill accompanying the recommendations of the Board of Harbor and Land Commissioners (House, No. 196). Harbors and Public Lands. January 3.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Removal of Material from Beaches.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Whoever shall take, carry away, or
2 remove by land or water any stones, gravel, sand or
3 other material from any beach, shore, bluff, head-
4 land, island or bar, in or bordering on tide waters,
5 excepting within the limits of Boston harbor as de-
6 fined in chapter seven hundred and forty-eight of
7 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and eleven,
8 without the consent in writing of the board of har-
9 bor and land commissioners, shall for each offence
10 forfeit and pay for the use of the commonwealth a
11 sum not less than twenty nor more than two hun-
12 dred dollars for each offence, to be recovered by
13 complaint or indictment in any court of competent
14 jurisdiction.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.
