The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the Board of Trustees of Hospitals for Consumptives to make Additional Accommodations for Patients at the Lakeville State Sanatorium.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. That the board of trustees of hospitals  
2 for consumptives be empowered to erect a pavilion for  
3 thirty patients, with quarters and equipments for nine  
4 employees, at the Lakeville Sanatorium, at the cost not  
5 exceeding thirteen thousand dollars, and further that the  
6 said board be authorized to make additions to the present  
7 wards for men and women providing for additional  
8 private rooms with baths at the Lakeville State Sana-  
9 torium, at a cost not exceeding six thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The sum of nineteen thousand dollars is  
2 hereby appropriated for carrying out the purposes of  
3 this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
