Bill accompanying the recommendations of the Trustees of Massachusetts Training Schools (House, No. 239). January 3.

The Commonwealth of Wassachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Industrial School for Boys.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. A sum not exceeding fifty-five thousand
- 2 two hundred and fifty dollars is hereby appropriated to
- 3 be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from
- 4 the ordinary revenue, for improvements at the industrial
- 5 school for boys, to be expended under the direction of
- 6 the trustees, for the following purposes: For general
- 7 improvements, including moving and remodelling a small
- 8 house into cottage tenement, enlarging a cottage basement.
- 9 storage for ensilage, a chicken house, platform scales,
- 10 and extensions of sidewalks, sewer beds, trunk line sewers,
- 11 and water pipe connections, a sum not exceeding five

- 12 thousand six hundred and fifty dollars; for explorations
- 13 and investigations for a water system, a sum not exceed-
- 14 ing seven hundred dollars; for two cottages each for
- 15 thirty boys and attendants, a sum not exceeding thirty-six
- 16 thousand four hundred dollars; for moving and remodel-
- 17 ling large farm barn, a sum not exceeding sixty-five hun-
- 18 dred dollars; for heating and furnishing two cottages, a
- 19 sum not exceeding six thousand dollars.
 - 1 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
