

HOUSE No. 805

Bill accompanying the petition of the register of probate and insolvency for the county of Middlesex for legislation to provide additional clerical assistance for his department. Public Service. January 10.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To provide Additional Clerical Assistance for the Register of Probate and Insolvency for the County of Middlesex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-nine of chapter one hun-
2 dred and sixty-four of the Revised Laws of said common-
3 wealth is hereby amended by substituting, in the four-
4 teenth line thereof, after the word "Middlesex" and be-
5 fore the word "thousand", the word : — eight, in place of
6 the word "four". Also in the fifteenth line thereof by
7 substituting in place of the word "the", occurring be-
8 fore the word "judge", the word : — a ; also in the seven-
9 teenth line thereof by substituting in place of the word
10 "the" the word : — a, — so that this section of said statute

11 shall read as follows:— of Middlesex, eight thousand
12 dollars, payable by the commonwealth upon the certifi-
13 cate of a judge of probate and insolvency, and two thou-
14 sand dollars from said county upon the certificate of the
15 register, countersigned by a judge of probate and insol-
16 vency.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter three hundred and eighty-seven
2 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and four and
3 chapter three hundred and fifty-three of the acts of the
4 year nineteen hundred and nine are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
