

HOUSE No. 940

Bill accompanying the petition of Nathan A. Tufts for legislation to provide for the maintenance of a recreation park in the city of Waltham by the Metropolitan Park Commission. Metropolitan Affairs. January 13.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Maintenance of a Recreation Park on the Charles River in the City of Waltham, by the Metropolitan Park Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to maintain a public
3 recreation park, with the necessary appurtenances, on
4 land heretofore taken by the commission on the bank
5 of the Charles river in Waltham. The commission may
6 establish rules and regulations governing the use of said
7 recreation park.

1 SECTION 2. For the above purpose the sum of one
2 thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid from

3 the treasury of the commonwealth out of the metropoli-
4 tan parks maintenance fund, and to be repaid to the
5 commonwealth by the cities and towns in the metro-
6 politan district in accordance with the provisions of
7 chapter four hundred and sixty-four of the acts of the
8 year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
